Building on the global impact of Future Search and its principles

This 3 day event is a unique opportunity for you to:

- meet Future Search practitioners and advocates from around the world and hear their stories,
- share your experience of Future Search and exchange ideas,
- learn about what we are doing as a network around the world,
- reflect on who we are touching through our work,
- explore how people are using the principles and philosophy of FS in meetings of all shapes and sizes, everyday,
- re-energise your practice and yourself, and have fun!

Who is it for?

This event is for anyone who is interested in applying FS principles in their work and their lives, not only for those who regularly lead Future Searches. Whether you have experience of many Future Searches – or are still trying to get your first one off the ground – the Learning Exchange is for you. You may even pick up the advice and support you need to help you create your first FS.

Specifically, The Learning Exchange is open to members of the FS Network and to practitioners working with other large scale, whole systems approaches to change including Open Space, World Café, Appreciative Inquiry etc.

What's the programme?

The programme will run from 4pm on Sunday until 2pm on Tuesday. On Sunday we'll devote time to getting to know each other and building the sense of our own community. On Monday and Tuesday we'll use Open Space as a framework for our conversations. We are planning an arts and cultural evening on Monday – so don't forget to bring along any music, poetry, comedy or other talents that you want to share!!

Where is it being held?

The Learning Exchange is being held at the beautiful learning centre Heerlijckyt van Elsmere, located about one hours drive from Brussels Airport (www.heerlijckyt.org.) With a castle, park and a farm on site, it's a peaceful and inspirational home for our meeting.

How much does it cost?

The cost for the three day workshop is 250 Euros, plus 21% tax. This does not include meals and accommodation, which cost an additional 377 Euros per person (in a private room) or 300 Euros if sharing.
